Important Points to Remember:

- PPE is an essential component of Standard and Transmission-Based Precautions
- Being able to correctly apply and remove PPE helps ensure that they work in the intended manner
- Keep gloved hands away from face and avoid touching or adjusting other PPE
- Remove gloves if they become torn; perform hand hygiene before donning new gloves
- Limit surfaces and items touched while wearing PPE

Applying Personal Protective Equipment

RATIONALE: To outline the sequence of events for appropriately applying (donning) Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

Sequence for donning PPE:

- 1. Hand Hygiene
- 2. Gown
- 3. Mask (cone, N-95 or respirator)
- 4. Eye Protection, if needed
- 5. Gloves



Donning PPE:

- 1. Perform Hand Hygiene then select the appropriate type and size of gown and secure at the neck and waist.
- Select the appropriate type of mask. Cone mask application: Place over nose, mouth and chin. Fit flexible nose piece over nose bridge; secure on head with ties or elastic and adjust to fit.
- For particulate respirator (N-95 mask): select fit tested respirator and place over nose, mouth and chin. Secure on head with elastic and adjust to fit. Perform a fit test by inhaling (respirator should collapse) and exhaling (check for leakage around face).
- 4. If eye protection is needed, position goggles over eyes and secure to the head using the ear pieces or headband. Adjust to fit comfortably.
- 5. Donning gloves should be last; select the correct type and size and insert hands into gloves. Extend gloves over gown cuff.
